strip-out and enabling works in several Warehouses at the Marks & Spencer Distribution Centre in Warrington.

Our Internal H & S Management Team successfully introduced a dust free floor plaining method to remove screed and asbestos bitumen adhesive from floated floor surfaces throughout the Warehouse. Our method of working was praised by the analysts who monitored the air quality during our works and provided evidence that their sampling was within Government guidelines.

We successfully identified waste streams and waste disposal routes to ensure zero % to landfill of non-asbestos containing materials.



We also co-ordinated the complex arrangements and documentation required to utilise a specialist 160 ton crane for the removal of M&E across the external Roof area.
