KpH have completed a 12 week strip-out and enabling project at the Belfry Shopping Centre in Redhill for our client, Wates. The project comprised the amalgamation of Units 17 and 18 at the Lower Mall Level and Units 24 – 29 at

the Upper Mall Level into one unit for a major retail chain. Works included demolition and dismantling of masonry walls; removal of internal shop fit, ceilings, floors, shopfront windows; and the formation of new slab openings. Key challenges were working around live services and active retail units, and managing noise pollution.
