project at the prestigious Adelphi Building in London. The 14 storey building remained live for the duration of the

refurbishment works, which took place on Level 12, 13 and the Roof. Particular attention had to be taken to minimise the disruption to all live areas and reduce noise and vibration during construction operations. Works included the removal of Plant Rooms, M&E, Absestos and all office fixtures and fittings.

Working as the Principal Contractor for our client, Page Surveyors, KpH Deconstruction completed a 3 x week programme to demolish a detached house, garage and out building at 1 James Lane in London. The



main challenge on this project was to complete the works within a very tight programme, which we accomplished



successfully. To prepare for the works, and ascertain if there were any unidentified services beneath the ground, KpH carried out a ground survey. We then liaised with the local authorities to carry out isolations at the boundary.
