KpH are really proud to announce that we have achieved our best results to date (a score of 43) for our latest Considerate Constructors Scheme audit at 155 Bishopsgate, where we have been awarded a **Certificate of Excellence**. KpH are particularly pleased to see that we have maintained our top score of 9 for Health and Safety, and that our Team's efforts to increase our focus on Environmental campaigns and innovation have been recognised.

One of these campaigns was called "Spotlight on Plastics and Packaging". We asked our staff at 155 Bishopsgate to spend a week collecting single-use plastic drinking bottles, that they would otherwise have thrown away. All were surprised at the number collected. A "living wall" was then created out of the bottles to remind staff to reduce plastic waste and raise awareness of campaigns such as #PassOnPlastic and #PledgeLessPlastic. A surprising side-effect of the living wall was that it made our demolition site look bright and cheery! We then launched our new KpH branded reusable bottles to help the cause.



In order to further our innovation on site, we have added a QR Code to safety-critical signage that, when scanned, connect the user to an audio translation of the information in multiple languages. We have included English language options so that those wishing to improve their understanding of the language, including English-speaking members of the team who struggle with reading and writing, can develop their knowledge and skillset in this area also. We are extremely proud of the Management Team's dedication to safeguarding the wellbeing of our workforce on site.
